Please be advised AMEB Qld has resumed face-to-face examinations at the Ashgrove Studios in Brisbane, and at some private venues. We look forward to the imminent resumption of face-to-face examinations in northern and central Queensland during sessions 6, 9, and 15 in August. Additional hygiene and cleaning protocols have been put in place to comply with all government health directives.

Any private venue which wishes to host AMEB examinations in Queensland must complete the Practical Examination Venue Questionnaire and sign the declaration that the venue can comply with COVID-19 safe directives and protocols for the State Manager's consideration, prior to examinations being delivered at any external location.

I am pleased to announce the AMEB Shop is taking online enrolments for two additional Video Repertoire Examination (VRE) sessions this week for all Queensland residents, irrespective of location. Sessions 74 and 78 are in place for this year only!

Certificate of Performance, AMusA and Speech and Drama video examinations can be conducted but enrolments will be taken on application and must be approved by the State Manager. Special conditions may apply. Enrollers or candidates considering these options, should contact AMEB Qld in the first instance.
