AMEB (Qld) appreciates your patience and continued support during a time of uncertainty and innovation while we modify our examination service delivery mode and model in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

As you will already be aware, we are facilitating transfers at no cost, to Video Examinations. Candidates enrolled in the postponed sessions 5, 8, 14, 51 & 22 will be able to record and upload a Video Repertoire Examination (VRE) or a For Leisure Video Repertoire Examination (FLRE) to *YouTube* and submit the link for assessment in a dedicated May 2020 session.

Enrollers must advise AMEB (Qld) by email at [enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au](mailto:enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au) for candidates wishing to transfer to the May Video Examination session **no later than 5pm Monday 20 April 2020**.

### Change of submission date:

In recognition of a candidate's requirement to learn another piece, I have changed the VRE and FLRE submission date for sessions 5, 8, 14, 51 & 22 to **Saturday 16 May 2020**.
